


The Campus Overview and Timeline



The property also boasts laundry facilities, picnic areas with gas grills, social lounges for gathering, and a Resident Council in each building to ensure voices are heard and needs are met. Adjacent parking adds to the convenience, making Simeanna Apartments a perfect blend of independence with community living.

The Simeanna Apartments Story:

Following a comprehensive community survey, we embarked on a transformative journey in 1968. In 1972, we proudly opened the doors to Simeanna I, providing 81 units of comfortable and secure living for seniors. The success of this venture inspired us to do even more. And in 1979, our commitment culminated in the launch of Simeanna III, further expanding the Simeanna community and accommodating an additional wave of residents. Carmel Residence provides independent living to seniors 55 and older who choose to live independently. Garage parking is available for a monthly fee. The complex contains six wings and a total of 72 apartments, offering a mixture of one and two-bedroom units, plus several guest rooms. The residence offers planned social, informational, and community involvement programs. Common areas include a dining room, which is also used for a variety of social activities, several lounge areas including a pub and solarium, and a library with books from the Oshkosh Public Library. Outdoor amenities feature gardens with seating, walking paths, a water feature, and enhanced landscaping, along with stand-up garden boxes for residents to create personal gardens. Carmel Residence is a pet-friendly building, including a fenced-in dog park. The building is secured with a remote doorbell/phone system, a staffed concierge desk in the 220 Westfield lobby during normal business hours, and 24-hour emergency maintenance phone coverage. Additional emotional support services include spiritual services with a variety of in-person and online worship services and programs, plus personal visits available to all residents of the Miravida Living community.

The Carmel Residence Story:

To meet the increasing need for independent living options, our organization made significant advancements with the development of Carmel Residence. The first phase of the building was opened in 1985 with 30 units. Recognizing the need for expansion, the first wing was added in 1987, followed by a second wing in 1991, culminating in a total of 72 units. Carmel Residence stands as a testament to our commitment to meeting the evolving needs of seniors and ensuring they have a range of thoughtful and supportive options as they journey through their later years. 


